

Millénaire Installer

This program is designed to make Millénaire easier to install and update by providing a graphical interface to do the following actions:

- Install Forge
- Install Millénaire

Limits of the installer

You should be aware of the following limitations/known bugs in this installer:

- It does no version compatibility checks (between Minecraft and Forge and between Forge and Millénaire). It is up to you to make sure you install versions compatible with each others.
- It does only token checks as to the validity of the minecraft jar, the Forge archive and the Millénaire archive. If they are damaged for whatever reason the installer will likely not detect it.
- It does not look for modified files in the millenaire directory. If you modified some, they will be over-written by the installer.
- The «download» buttons do not seem to work on 64bit Linux environments.

Instructions

The installer proceeds in three steps, that each have to be validated before the next one: locating the Minecraft folder, installing Forge and installing Millénaire. Each of those step is represented by a dedicated rectangular area on the left side of the installer window.

Locating the Minecraft folder

The installer will automatically attempt to locate the «minecraft» (Mac) or «.minecraft» (Windows and Linux) directory at the default location. If it is found, the path to it will be displayed and a green tick will show the location was successful. If it was not, because you installed Minecraft elsewhere than the default location, use the «Select Folder» button to locate it manually.

Installing Forge

Once a Minecraft folder is located, the installer will check to see if Forge seems installed in it. If it is, a green check will be shown and you can proceed to the next step. If it isn't, you need the latest Forge jar. You can download it from the Forge website - clicking the «Download» button will take you there. If you download it in one of three locations the installer should automatically detect it: Downloads, Documents or the Desktop. If the installer doesn't, you need to select it manually.

Once a Forge jar file has been located, press «install» to install it. The Forge installer will launch. Once the install is complete, a green check should then appear, and you can proceed to the next step.

Installing Millénaire

Once both steps above are validated, you can install Millénaire itself. To download the latest version, go to millenaire.org or click on «download» to be taken there. If you download it in one of three locations the installer should automatically detect it:

Downloads, Documents or the Desktop. If the installer doesn't, you need to select it manually.

Alternatively, if you are a registered donor, you have access to a «direct download» button that will download it from within the installer.

Compatibility with other install methods

The installation of Millénaire itself touches only Millénaire files and should have no impact on other mods.
